All of the tires, paint, propane tanks, batteries, computers, televisions, microwaves and Freon appliances were collected and segregated at the Landfill. All metal and appliances were collected together for a total of 40 metric tonnes using both the H & H Huxted bins and Town staff. The total 269.47 metric tonnes of household includes; wood, compost, & household materials. Town staff collected and delivered 142.01 metric tonnes of household materials and compost, with 127.46 metric tonnes delivered in the bins. Compared to last year totals we had an decrease of 4.9 % in wood, compost, and household material and a 21.6 % decrease in metal.
