All of the tires, paint, propane tanks, batteries, computers, televisions, microwaves and Freon appliances were collected and segregated at the Landfill. All metal and appliances were collected together for a total of 46 metric tonnes using both the H & H Huxted bins and Town staff. The total 197.39 metric tonnes of household includes; wood, compost, & household materials. Town staff collected and delivered 62.77 metric tonnes of household materials and compost, with 134.62 metric tonnes delivered in the bins. Compared to last year totals we had an approximate decrease of 27 % in wood, compost, and household material and a 17 % increase in metal.
