PROCLAMATION

National Day of Mourning

April 28, 2018

WHEREAS: This annual Day of Mourning commemorates the sacrifices made by workers who have died or who have been injured or disabled on the job during the past year; and

WHEREAS: In 2017, 166 Alberta workers died from workplace injury or disease – leaving many families to mourn.

WHEREAS: This annual National Day of Mourning is an opportunity to rededicate ourselves to the goal of making our workplace safer, which is something we can only achieve by working together.

THEREFORE: I, Mayor Heather Colberg, do hereby proclaim **April 28, 2018** as "**National Day of Mourning**" in the Town of Drumheller.

On Saturday, April 28th our flags will be lowered in remembrance of those workers who have been killed, injured or disabled at their place of work.

PROCLAMATION

National Organ and Tissue Donation Awareness Week April 22 - 28, 2018

WHEREAS: Approximately 4,500 Canadians are waiting for a lifesaving organ transplant and many more are waiting for tissue transplants. The sad reality is that on average, 250 Canadians die each year waiting for a transplant.

WHEREAS: Albertans are encouraged to visit myhealth.alberta.ca to register as organ and tissue donors during National Organ and Tissue Donation Awareness Week. They are also reminded to have important conversations with loved ones about their organ donation wishes. And to spread the word about the critical need for more donors.

THEREFORE: I, Mayor Heather Colberg, who is a strong believer in organ donation hereby proclaim April 22nd to 28th, 2018 as National Organ and Tissue Donation Awareness Week in the Town of Drumheller.

Late Humboldt Broncos player Logan Boulet signed his donor card merely weeks earlier. That decision saved 6 lives.
