SUMMARY

Town of Drumheller's plans are to implement a flood mitigation and climate adaptation system for the entire community. The past two decades have seen Drumheller challenged with rising waters, ice jams and storms along with declarations of a State of Local Emergency to combat rising floodwaters. Drumheller will be submitting an application under the Disaster Mitigation and Adaption Fund to the Federal and Provincial governments to help pay for this system. The Town's share of funding will be \$5.0M.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council move forward with a motion that would see significant funding for our community for the protection of major flood events.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Funding share Federal / Provincial / Municipal levels of government. The funding for this project will be cash flowed over several years with the total commitment being \$5.0M

STRATEGIC POLICY ALIGNMENT:

Council Strategic Priority since 2013.

MOTION:

That Council approve \$5.0m as the Town's share of funding under the Federal Government's Disaster Mitigation Adaptation Fund to build a climate adaptable dyke system along a 40 km stretch of the Town of Drumheller in the Red Deer River Basin.
